COUNT 1

This information is based on evidence obtained from witness Wayne Hansen.


PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT


The undersigned prosecutor is a Deputy Davis County Attorney and has received information from the investigating officer, Wayne Hansen, and the information herein is based upon such personal observations and investigation of said officer.

On July 16, 2015 the defendant entered onto the parking strip of the Lagoon Annex located in Farmington City to engage in a public gathering of multiple people to protest Lagoon's operation of a zoo facility, without first obtaining a permit as required by Farmington City Code despite knowing such permit is required by a public protest.
